But the money we raise now is no longer simply for St. Nicholas House; as we pay off that loan, we are also preparing for <u>future</u> property acquisition. In the past 12 months, three properties adjacent or near to the monastery have come on the market. Although we were unable to make any offers because of our existing obligations, we believe that the future life of the monastery will include such property acquisition. Additional parcels will allow for clergy and pilgrim housing, both of which are essential to the long-term viability of the monastery.
